

Uganda and Africa

L.O. *What do we know about Africa?*

Starter: *What is 'AFRICA'?* Write down all the words that come in to your head when you think of 'AFRICA'. (Also interesting for teachers to do this activity then share their ideas!)

Activity 2: *Meet the students:* Play the videos introducing the students ([here](http://uganda2009.wordpress.com/2009/01/12/meet-the-students/): <http://uganda2009.wordpress.com/2009/01/12/meet-the-students/>). Who are they? How are they feeling? *(Emphasise that they are real students, who are really going to Uganda in the summer: You will be able to follow their preparations on through the blog. After they return, your students will be able to find out all about their expedition through the website. If you would like them to come in to meet your class / do an assembly, please ask us.)*

Activity 3: *What would you be feeling?* Imagine you are going to Uganda in the summer. Write down everything you would be feeling. (Again the teacher could also do this!) Snowball these ideas (i.e. first do the mind map on your own, then share in pairs, fours and finally as a whole class). Then (if there's time): *What do you think Uganda will be like?* Write down all your thoughts. (Again snowball the ideas).

Activity 4: *What would you say?* If they were going to Uganda in the summer, what might they say on an introduction video clip? Write a short speech to present to the class.

Plenary: Present speeches to the class.

Possible homework: What words do people at home think of when they hear the word 'AFRICA'?
